The schedule of events is as follows:

Day 1 (Friday, 6th March, 2020) – SHE-lympics will see 12 – 16 all-girls’ teams (the future of women) from schools affiliated to the Archdiocesan Board of Education (ABE) participate in a fun evening of tele-games spread across St. Andrew High School quadrangle and St. Andrew’s Turf Park from 5pm onwards. The new basketball court (on the School quadrangle) conceptualised and designed by Adidas will also be inaugurated. There are trophies and cash prizes to be won as well as certificates and tons of give-aways for all participants.

Day 2: Saturday, 7th March, 2020 – The SHE-roes Conclave brings together women from different walks of life and different strata of society who have fought or continue to fight for change in the status quo of women. Meet Capt. Keithair Misquitta, Ms. Licypriya Kangujam, Dr. Snehal Pinto, Dr. Kanak Rele, Ms. Anna Bredemeyer, Ms. Zelma Lazarus and many more as they speak on their experiences while bringing about change. The Conclave takes place at St. Andrew’s Conference Hall from 9am to 2pm. There is a registration fee of Rs. 200 which includes breakfast, snacks, lunch and a participation certificate. There are also exciting takeaways for all attendees.

Day 3: Sunday, 8th March, 2020 – SHE-nanigans, an evening of masti and entertainment focused on women, takes place on St. Andrew High School grounds from 6pm onwards. The entertainment includes well-known entertainment group, Infrared, along with other dance performances. There will also be stalls selling food items, jewellery, clothing, etc. made mostly by women as well as food stalls selling a variety of cuisines. Entry is open to all.
