# POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH OPPORTUNITY

- **Humboldt Research Fellowship for Postdoctoral Researchers:**
  - long-term research (6-24 months) in Germany,
  - Scientists and scholars of all nationalities and disciplines may apply,
  - approximately 500 fellowships are granted annually,
  - **Eligibility: Doctorate completed less than four years prior to the date of application**

## ■ Fulbright-Nehru Postdoctoral Research Fellowships

- These fellowships are designed for Indian faculty and researchers who are in the early stages of their research careers in India.
- The Postdoctoral Research Fellowships will provide opportunities to talented faculty and researchers to strengthen their research capacities.
- These fellowships are for eight to twenty-four months.
- The applicant should have a Ph.D. degree within the past four years

## ■ **The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)**

- **For outstanding postdoctoral researchers from all disciplines and nationalities**
- **Funding is provided for 18 months, in which 12 months have to be spent abroad and 6 months (re-integration phase) at a German university.**
